



## Application for authorisation of AN parallel trade

([Art. 13a para 1bis OBP](#); CC 813.12)

This form concerns biocidal products under the terms of Art. 13a 1bis OBP which are **identical** with a reference product authorised in Switzerland under the transitional regulation (AN authorisation) AND are placed on the market in an EU or EFTA member state (country of origin) in accordance with the national provisions there.

“Identical” means that the biocidal product **completely** coincides with the reference product in the following terms:<sup>1</sup>

- Composition
- It is manufactured by the same company, by an affiliated company or under licence using the same manufacturing process
- User category (public, professionals)
- Place of use (indoors, buildings for livestock, hospitals, in cooling systems, etc.)
- Product types
- Type of preparation (aerosol, powder, etc.).
- It is identical or equivalent to its size, material and form of packaging in terms of potential adverse effects on human or animal health or on the environment.

Authorisation for AN parallel trade is subject to the same terms and conditions as applicable to the reference product.

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<sup>1</sup> If the reference product has been authorised for several types of use, user categories and/or product types, the application for the identical product does not necessarily have to be for them all. However, no authorisation for AN parallel trade will be granted for types of use, user categories and/or product types which are not authorised for the reference product.
